BMKF Application Guidelines

The Bo M. Karlsson Foundation awards higher education scholarships to women in Nepal for bachelor's degree and trade certificate programs. BMKF supports promising students with great financial need and other challenges to education, including caste, ethnic group, and disabilities.

Application Deadline: November 11, 2016

I. ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- BMKF awards scholarships to women only.
- Bachelor's degree candidates must have a minimum of 55% marks (Second Division) in Class 12/+2 from a non-science faculty or a minimum of 65% marks (First Division) from a science faculty. In addition, candidates must pass all subjects for years 11 and 12.
- Trade certificate candidates must have a minimum grade average of C+ for Class 10/SLC from a government school or a B average from a private school, and pass all subjects for year 10.

II. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Scholarship candidates must submit the following documents:

- BMKF Scholarship Application
- A personal essay
- Three letters of recommendation:
 - 1) District or village office letter describing your financial need
 - 2) Teacher or academic advisor recommendation
 - 3) A personal reference
- Transcripts, including SLC and HSEB (10+2) Exam Results
- Estimated Expenses Form
